

STATEMENT OF THE DATA CONTROLLER

1. The controller of personal data is Sopockie Towarzystwo Ubezpieczeń na Życie ERGO Hestia SA (hereinafter referred to also as “ERGO Hestia”). Data subject can contact the data controller via:

2. The data controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer available for contact in all matters regarding the processing of personal data and the exercise of data subject’s rights related to data processing. Contact details of the Data Protection Officer:

3. Data controller processes personal data for the following purposes:
 - 1) contact relating to conclusion and performance of the contract between the data controller and the entity on behalf of which you act as a contact person, plenipotentiary or other person acting in the name of that entity;
 - 2) archiving;
 - 3) customer service via hotline — your personal data may be processed in the form of a recorded conversation.
4. Legal basis for processing of personal data:
 - 1) legitimate interest of the data controller;
 - 2) compliance with the legal obligations of the data controller.
5. Personal data have been obtained from the entity you represent with which the data controller has concluded a contract in the following scope: name, surname, phone/mobile number, e-mail address.
6. Personal data may be transferred to entities processing personal data at the request of ERGO Hestia, among others IT service providers, provision of archiving services, law firms, postal and courier services, auditors.
7. Persons whose personal data are being processed by ERGO Hestia are entitled the following rights regarding the processing:
 - 1) the right to access their personal data;
 - 2) the right to request its rectification (correction), deletion or restriction of its processing;
 - 3) the right to object to the processing of their personal data – within the scope of processing **upon legitimate interest of the data controller**;
 - 4) the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority responsible for the protection of personal data.
8. In order to exercise the above rights, please contact the data administrator or the Data Protection Officer.
9. Personal data shall be stored until the expiry of the limitation period for claims under the contract concluded with the entity you represent or until the legal obligation to store the data expires.
